Hi Students and Families:

For this week -- the Confirmation Year 1 Team would like you to reflect on the Christian feast known as the Epiphany. This holiday takes place on January 6th to celebrate the revelation of God incarnate as Jesus Christ. The feast honors the visit of Magi to the Christ child; therefore, leading to Jesus's physical manifestation to the Gentiles. It is sometimes called "Three Kings Day" referring to the three wise men or Magi. In accordance to the Gospel Matthew, the men found the divine child by following a bright star in the sky across the desert for twelve days to Bethlehem.

Questions for Students to Answer:

1. In your top left hand corner of the "**Epiphany**" handout attached to the email, answer the question under "***Faith Focus***".
2. Read **AND** answer the questions in the "**Inviting Jesus In**" handout. Be sure to either print the handout to submit your drawing, or submit your drawing as a ".jpg" file format.
